- 2018-016, which authorizes the Executive Director to execute a memorandum of understanding (MOU) to guide coordination of federal performance planning requirements

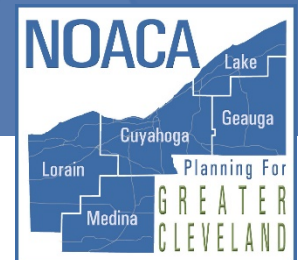
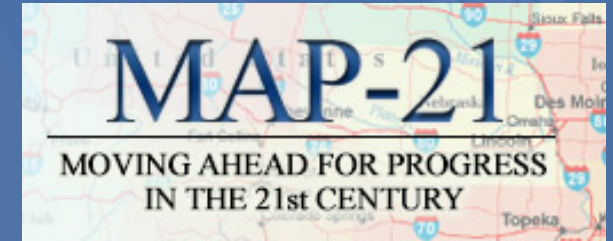
PREVIOUS ACTION

BACKGROUND

- MAP-21 and FAST Act require a collaborative implementation of transportation performance management
- 23 CFR 450.314(h) – Requires MPOs, State DOTs and Transit Operators to agree upon and develop written procedures for:
 - Cooperative development and sharing of performance data information
 - Selection of performance targets
 - Reporting of performance targets
 - Tracking progress toward attainment



BACKGROUND

- **Required performance measure areas include:**
 - Safety
 - Bridge and Pavement Condition
 - Freight Movement
 - System Reliability
 - Non-SOV / CMAQ
 - Transit Asset Management / Safety

BACKGROUND

- Final draft MOU has been developed by ODOT transit agencies input
- MOU addresses the following:
 - Coordination, obligations and responsibilities of each party
 - Deadlines for TPM related activities
 - Data metrics and sources
 - Target setting, adjustment and reporting
- MOU's are currently being executed by transit agencies
