<u>WHEREAS</u>, Ms. Gallucci's contract requires the consent of the Governing Board in order to accept any outside employment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency, consisting of forty-four principal elected and other officials of general purpose local government throughout the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, and Medina:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the Executive Director, Grace Gallucci, has the support and encouragement of the Governing Board to teach no more than one college course per semester from the time period of January 2013 through July 2015.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the Executive Director shall inform the Governing Board of each teaching invitation accepted.
