RE: **Resolution No. 2014-044 – Project Planning Reviews – 1st Quarter State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2015**

ACTION REQUESTED

The Board of Directors is asked to approve **Resolution No. 2014-044**, which acknowledges that the projects included in the resolution have successfully completed project planning review (PPR). The Planning and Programming Committee recommends this action.

BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION FOR CURRENT ACTION

Attached is a list of the proposed projects that were presented to the NOACA Transportation Subcommittee (TS) at its July 18, 2014 meeting, the NOACA Planning and Programming Committee at its August 8, 2014 meeting and to the NOACA Executive Committee at its September 12, 2014 meeting in accordance with the PPR process. All three committees have recommended their approval.

NOACA's Regional Transportation Investment Policy (Resolution 2012-023) requires that all proposed federal-aid transportation projects be processed through PPR in order to meet NOACA's adopted goals and federal requirements.

PPR consists of four components: staff review, committee review, intergovernmental review and consultation (IGRC), and public involvement. The end product of PPR is a Board resolution that certifies that the project has had thorough review, allowing the project to proceed to the programming stages of the planning process.

As part of the PPR process, a detailed summary of the proposed improvement and staff and committee assessment of the project are posted on NOACA's website, www.NOACA.org. A link to the PPRs is included on the home page by clicking the 'Comment of Projects' button. Staff adds comments obtained from the public, governmental organizations and NOACA committees as they are received. Proposed projects are posted on the website for three months, allowing adequate time for review and comment.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated total cost of the proposed projects is approximately \$151.8 million, which includes approximately \$17.7 million in NOACA-controlled funds. Funding for these projects is being provided from a variety of federal, state, and local sources. Federal funding is provided by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration and is administered through NOACA and the Ohio Department of Transportation.

CONCLUSION/NEXT STEPS

Project sponsors will be notified that their project has completed PPR. NOACA staff will work with project sponsors to address any planning issues identified during PPR.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE
NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, and Medina, and the areawide water quality management agency for the same region; and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States, through law, and the U.S. Department of Transportation, through regulation, have determined that a long-range transportation plan and a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that include federal-aid transportation projects expected to be implemented during their time frames shall be prepared; and

WHEREAS, the NOACA's Regional Transportation Investment Policy (Resolution No. 2012-023) requires that all proposed federal-aid transportation projects be processed through project planning review in order to meet transportation plan goals and federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, project planning review consists of staff technical and policy assessment, committee review, public involvement, and Intergovernmental Review and Consultation; and

WHEREAS, the following projects have been processed through project planning review:

- a) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY US-6 - 21.27: PID No. 94577 - This project involves the upgrade of the stone arch drainage structure carrying Dugaway Brook under Euclid Avenue (US-6), located just east of Superior Avenue, in East Cleveland.
- b) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY SR-14 - 2.19 PAINT: PID No. 90202 - This project involves painting the bridge on Broadway Avenue (SR-14), over IR-490, in Cleveland.
- c) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-71 - 17.95L: PID No. 81552 - This project involves replacing the deck of the SR-176 southbound bridge, over IR-71 southbound, in Cleveland.
- d) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-90 - 24.10/24.63: PID No. 88348 - This project involves replacing the decks of the mainline IR-90 bridges, over East 140th Street and East 152nd Street, in Cleveland.
- e) City of Cleveland: CUY CLEVE/CUY CO PORT AUTHORITY CRANES - This project involves the construction of two cranes for unloading general cargo at the Port of Cleveland to support its liner cargo service between Cleveland and Europe.
- f) City of Westlake: CUY IR-90/SR-252 INTERCHANGE - This project involves modifications and improvements to the interchange at IR-90 and SR-252, in Westlake.
- g) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY D12 GR FY2016: PID No. 97311 - This project involves guardrail upgrade and repair on various routes and sections in Cuyahoga, Geauga and Lake Counties.

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- h) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY D12 PM FY2016: PID No. 97291 - This project involves pavement marking on various routes and sections in Cuyahoga, Geauga and Lake Counties.
- i) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY SR-17 - 12.16: PID No. 94721 - This project involves resurfacing SR-17 (Granger Road), from the Brooklyn Heights west corporation line (WCL) to Tuxedo Avenue, in Brooklyn Heights.
- j) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-71 - 10.48: PID No. 85529 - This project involves preventive maintenance on IR-71, from IR-480 to the Brooklyn west corporation line (WCL), in Cleveland.
- k) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-271 - 9.73: PID No. 90900 - This project involves preventive maintenance on IR-271, from Fairmount Boulevard to Wilson Mills Road, in Beachwood, Lyndhurst, Mayfield Heights and Mayfield.
- l) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): GEA SR-87 - 00.00: PID No. 85601 - This project involves resurfacing SR-87 (Kinsman Road), from the Cuyahoga County Line to the Chillicothe Road (SR-306), in Russell Township.
- m) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): GEA SR-528 - 1.29: PID No. 90908 - This project involves resurfacing SR-528 (Madison Road), from Nash Road (SR-88) to Kinsman Road (SR-87), in Parkman Township, Middlefield Township and the Village of Middlefield.
- n) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): GEA SR-700 - 00.00: PID No. 85605 - This project involves resurfacing SR-700 (Claridon-Troy Road), from the Portage County Line to US-422, in Troy Township.
- o) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): LAK SR-44 - 4.14: PID No. 85532 VAR - This project involves resurfacing SR-44, from SR-84 (Johnnycake Ridge Road) to Headlands Park, in Painesville Township, Painesville and Grand River; and on SR-2, from SR-44 to the Painesville west corporation line (WCL), in Painesville Township.
- p) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-271 - 10.87: PID No. 97676 - This project involves modifications to the interchange at IR-271 and Brainard Road, in Lyndhurst.
- q) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-480 - 22.41EB: PID No. 89168 - This project involves the addition of an auxiliary lane on IR-480 eastbound, from Lee Road to Northfield Road, in Maple Heights, Cleveland and Warrensville Heights.
- r) City of Brecksville: CUY BRECKSVILLE RD SIGNALS - This project involves upgrading traffic signals along Brecksville Road, from Snowville Road to Wallings Road, in Brecksville.
- s) City of Rocky River: CUY CENTER RIDGE RD SIGNALS - This project involves upgrading traffic signals along Center Ridge Road, from Spencer Road to Wooster Road, in Rocky River.

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- t) City of Cleveland: CUY CLARK AVE SIGNALS – This project involves upgrading traffic signals along Clark Avenue, from Lorain Avenue to West 14th Street, in Cleveland.
- u) City of Willoughby: LAK SR-84 SIGNALS - This project involves the installation of traffic signals along SR-84 (Ridge Road) at the intersections of Robinhood Drive, Shankland Road and Willoughcroft Road, in Willoughby.
- v) City of Avon: LOR AVON SIGNALS - This project involves upgrading traffic signals at 37 intersections along Center Road (SR-83), Nagel Road, Detroit Road (SR-254), Lorain Avon Road (SR-611) and Chester Road, in Avon.
- w) City of Lorain: LOR LORAIN SIGNALS - This project involves replacement of traffic signals at intersections along Broadway and 28th Street, in Lorain.
- x) City of Cleveland: CUY JOHNSTON MILL RUN TRAIL PHASE I - This project involves the construction of a four-mile, off-road shared-use path facility, north of Broadway, from Miles Avenue to Lee Road and Kerruish Park, in Cleveland.
- y) Cleveland Metroparks: CUY RED LINE GREENWAY PHASES I and II - This project involves the construction of a multi-purpose trail from West 53rd Street, north of I-90, along the GCRTA Red Line Rapid Transit corridor, to the intersection of Columbus Road and Franklin Avenue, in Cleveland.
- z) Cleveland Metroparks: CUY VALLEY PARKWAY CONNECTOR PHASE II - This project involves the construction of an all purpose trail, from Ridge Road to Broadview Road, in North Royalton and Broadview Heights.
- aa) Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA): CUY GCRTA HAYDEN GARAGE CNG FACILITY - This project involves the installation of a compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling system at GCRTA's Hayden Bus Garage, in Cleveland.
- bb) Laketrans: LAKETRAN VEHICLE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM - This program involves Laketrans's purchase of replacement vans and buses in calendar years 2015 through 2020 for paratransit service and commuter service.
- cc) City of Elyria: LOR SR-57 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-57 (Lorain Boulevard), from SR-113 to the Ohio Turnpike off ramp, in Elyria.
- dd) Cities of Willoughby and Willoughby Hills: LAK SR-91 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-91 (SOM Center Road), from the Lake/Cuyahoga County Line to US-20, in Willoughby and Willoughby Hills.
- ee) Cities of Parma, Parma Heights, Middleburg Heights and Cleveland: CUY US-42 - This project involves pavement repairs along US-42 (Pearl Road), from Sprague Road to Wetzel Avenue, in Parma, Parma Heights, Middleburg Heights and Cleveland.
- ff) Cities of Maple Heights, Bedford, and Bedford Heights: CUY SR-8 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-8 (Northfield Road), from the Maple Heights, Bedford, and Bedford Heights corporation limits to the North Randall south corporation line, in Maple

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Heights, Bedford Heights and Warrensville Heights.

- gg) Cities of Cleveland, Parma, and Brooklyn: CUY RIDGE RD - This project involves pavement repairs along Ridge Road, from Pearl Road to Flowerdale Avenue, in Cleveland, Parma and Brooklyn.
- hh) City of Mayfield Heights: CUY US-322 - This project involves pavement repairs along US-322 (Mayfield Road), from Eastwood Avenue to Lander Road in Mayfield Heights.
- ii) City of Strongsville: CUY US-42 - This project involves pavement repairs along US-42 (Pearl Road), from Shurmer Road south of the Ohio Turnpike access road in Strongsville.
- jj) Cities of Brook Park, Parma, Parma Heights, and Middleburg Heights: CUY W 130TH ST - This project involves pavement repairs along West 130th Street, from Pleasant Valley Road to Snow Road in Brook Park, Parma, Parma Heights and Middleburg Heights.
- kk) City of Brook Park: CUY SNOW RD - This project involves pavement repairs along Snow Road, from SR-237 to Van Wert Avenue, in Brook Park.
- ll) City of Parma: CUY PLEASANT VALLEY RD - This project involves pavement repairs along Pleasant Valley Road, from State Road to Broadview Road, in Parma.
- mm) Cities of Avon and Avon Lake: LOR SR-83 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-83 (Center Road), from Detroit Road to Walker Road, in Avon and Avon Lake.
- nn) City of Shaker Heights: CUY WARRENSVILLE CENTER RD - This project involves pavement repairs along Warrensville Center Road, from Farnsleigh Road to Fairmount Boulevard, in Shaker Heights.
- oo) City of Euclid: CUY SR-175 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-175 (East 260th Street), from Euclid Avenue to IR-90, in Euclid.
- pp) City of Mentor: LAK SR-306 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-306 (Reynolds Road), from Johnnycake Ridge Road to the Lakeshore Boulevard, in Mentor.
- qq) City of Willoughby: LAK ERIE ST - This project involves the reconstruction of Erie Street, from US-20 (Mentor Avenue) to Stevens Boulevard, in Willoughby.

WHEREAS, the project planning reviews may contain recommendations that require project sponsor attention or action; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the project sponsors will, in good faith, endeavor to address comments and recommendations and will provide evidence of such, prior to the project advancing; and

WHEREAS, the above project planning reviews were recommended by the Transportation Subcommittee (TS), the Planning and Programming Committee and the Executive Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency, consisting of 45 principal officials serving general purpose local

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governments throughout and within the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, and Medina that:

Section 1: The referenced projects have successfully completed project planning review. The project planning reviews are a part of the projects' permanent record, and will be used in future programming and prioritization decisions. The projects are not subject to additional planning review unless there are significant changes in scope or finances, as determined by the Transportation Subcommittee.

Section 2: The project sponsors must endeavor to comply with any recommendations that have occurred as a result of the project planning review and will provide evidence of such in coordination meetings with NOACA staff. NOACA staff will report back to appropriate NOACA committees and the Board regarding the coordination meetings.

Section 3: The Executive Director is authorized to transmit certified copies of this resolution to appropriate federal, state, and local agencies.
