RE: **Resolution No. 2014-045 – Plan and TIP Amendments – 1st Quarter State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2015**

ACTION REQUESTED

The Board of Directors is asked to approve **Resolution No. 2014-045**, which directs that NOACA's long-range transportation plan (Plan) and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) be amended to include the proposed projects as indicated. Please note that some of the projects listed are to be amended to the Plan, some to the TIP and others to both the Plan and TIP. The Planning and Programming Committee recommends this action.

BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION FOR CURRENT ACTION

The proposed amendments to the Plan and the state fiscal year (SFY) 2014 – 2017 TIP have all been processed through project planning review (PPR). The projects include bridge, maintenance, resurfacing, roadway, safety, shared use paths, and traffic signals sponsored by various entities.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated total cost of the proposed projects is approximately \$151.8 million, which includes approximately \$17.7 million of NOACA controlled funds. Funding for these projects is being provided from a variety of federal, state, and local sources. Federal funding is provided by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration and is administered through NOACA and the Ohio Department of Transportation.

CONCLUSION/NEXT STEPS

Following Board approval, the amendment will be incorporated into the statewide TIP amendment in October 2014.

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, and Medina, and the areawide water quality management agency for the same region; and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States, through law, and the U.S. Department of Transportation, through regulation, have determined that MPOs shall create a long-range, 20-year transportation plan and a four-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that list federal-aid transportation projects expected to be implemented in each of the program years; and

WHEREAS, the NOACA Board of Directors' Regional Transportation Investment Policy requires that all proposed federal-aid transportation projects be processed through project planning review in order to meet transportation plan goals and federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the following projects are proposed amendments to the NOACA long-range transportation plan (Connections⁺ 2035):

- a) City of Brecksville: CUY BRECKSVILLE RD SIGNALS - This project involves upgrading traffic signals along Brecksville Road, from Snowville Road to Wallings Road, in Brecksville.
- b) City of Rocky River: CUY CENTER RIDGE RD SIGNALS - This project involves upgrading traffic signals along Center Ridge Road, from Spencer Road to Wooster Road, in Rocky River.
- c) City of Cleveland: CUY CLARK AVE SIGNALS – This project involves upgrading traffic signals along Clark Avenue, from Lorain Avenue to West 14th Street, in Cleveland.
- d) City of Cleveland: CUY CLEVE/CUY CO PORT AUTHORITY CRANES - This project involves the construction of two cranes for unloading general cargo at the Port of Cleveland to support its liner cargo service between Cleveland and Europe.
- e) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY D12 GR FY2016: PID No. 97311 - This project involves guardrail upgrade and repair on various routes and sections in Cuyahoga, Geauga and Lake Counties.
- f) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY D12 PM FY2016: PID No. 97291 - This project involves pavement marking on various routes and sections in Cuyahoga, Geauga and Lake Counties.
- g) City of Westlake: CUY IR-90/SR-252 INTERCHANGE - This project involves modifications and improvements to the interchange at IR-90 and SR-252, in Westlake.
- h) City of Cleveland: CUY JOHNSTON MILL RUN TRAIL PHASE I - This project involves the construction of a four-mile, off-road shared-use path facility, north of Broadway, from Miles Avenue to Lee Road and Kerruish Park, in Cleveland.

- i) City of Parma: CUY PLEASANT VALLEY RD - This project involves pavement repairs along Pleasant Valley Road, from State Road to Broadview Road, in Parma.
- j) Cleveland Metroparks: CUY RED LINE GREENWAY PHASE 1 - This project involves the construction of a multi-purpose trail from West 41st Street, north of I-90, along the GCRTA Red Line Rapid Transit corridor, to the intersection of Columbus Road and Franklin Avenue, in Cleveland.

- x) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY SR-17 - 12.16: PID No. 94721 - This project involves resurfacing SR-17 (Granger Road), from the Brooklyn Heights west corporation line (WCL) to Tuxedo Avenue, in Brooklyn Heights.

- kk) City of Mentor: LAK SR-306 - This project involves pavement repairs along SR-306 (Reynolds Road), from Johnnycake Ridge Road to the Lakeshore Boulevard, in Mentor.

- g) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-271 - 10.87: PID No. 97676 - This project involves modifications to the interchange at IR-271 and Brainard Road, in Lyndhurst.
- h) Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT): CUY IR-480 - 22.41EB: PID No. 89168 - This project involves the addition of an auxiliary lane on IR-480 eastbound, from Lee Road to Northfield Road, in Maple Heights, Cleveland and Warrensville Heights.

WHEREAS, all above projects are excluded from regional emissions analysis and as such do not affect the existing plan and TIP's air quality conformity determination; and

WHEREAS, the above projects are consistent with current financial forecasts and plans; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the project sponsors will, in good faith, endeavor to address comments and recommendations raised during project planning review and will provide evidence of such, prior to the project advancing; and

WHEREAS, the above projects are recommended by the Transportation Subcommittee (TS), Planning and Programming Committee and the Executive Committee as amendments to the Plan and TIP as appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency, consisting of 45 principal officials serving general purpose local governments throughout and within the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, and Medina that:

Section 1: The referenced projects in Attachment A have had appropriate review and are recommended for approval.

Section 2: The NOACA transportation plan and TIP are amended to include the projects in Attachment A for project development and processing review purposes.

Section 3: The Executive Director is authorized to transmit certified copies of this resolution to appropriate federal, state, and local agencies.
